- The total number and dollar volume of trade transactions financed by the Global Trade Finance Program's network of emerging-market banks are based on actual data from 100% of the network's active banks for CY23. This data represents total transactions executed by network banks supported by the GTFP program. The figures are not directly comparable to last year's due to variance in the number of active banks in the program and those who submitted survey responses. CY22 data has been updated to reflect prior-year data corrections from survey participants.
- One client in Europe contributed 51.4 MW data center capacity in CY23.
- One client in Africa contributed 0.4 million gas distribution customers reached in CY23.
- One client in South Asia contributed 44.7 million internet connections in CY23.
- One client in East Asia and the Pacific contributed 320 million patients served in CY23.
- One client in Central Asia and Türkiye contributed 366.5 million road/bus passengers in CY23.
- One client in Central Asia and Türkiye contributed 291 Mm3 sewage and wastewater treated in CY23.
